## Major Events & Achievements

- 1. Amendment in Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997 and Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 to introduce a common counseling for admission to all Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses in all Medical Educational Institutions on the basis of merit list of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test issued.
- 2. Amendment in Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulations, 1998 issued.
- 3. A notification dated 15.3.2017 has been published to amend the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules, 1945 to declare 3 laboratories of National Institute of Biologicals, Noida namely Enzymes & Hormones; Bacterial Vaccine and Viral Vaccine as Central Drugs Laboratories.
- 4. After the review of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), the following important systemic innovations have been introduced:
  - a) PSUs have been engaged as "Executing Agency" rather than as "Project Management Consultant" (PMC) for all new projects;
  - b) Third party quality assurance agencies have been appointed for better assurance and monitoring of quality, independent of the executing agencies;
  - c) Project Management Softwares (PRIMAVERA/MS Project) have been implemented for improved project management;
  - d) A Web based Dashboard to monitor all PMSSY projects has been developed.
- 5. For roll out of Universal Population based screening for NCDs, Training of Trainers (ToT) for ANMs and ASHAs completed for 32 State/UTs and 30 States/UTs respectively.
- 6. For operationalising strengthening Sub Centres to Health and Wellness Centres, Guidelines for proposing Health and Wellness Centres issued to States/UTs and Bridge Course for Nurses to develop as Community Health Officers initiated.
- 7. "Kilkari" rolled out in Haryana and Himachal Pradesh.
- 8. National Programme Coordination Committee meeting to appraise the NHM programme Implementation Plans for 2017-18 held for four(4) States Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh.
- 9. A meeting between Hon'ble HFM and H.E. Lawrence MacAulay, Minister of Agriculture & Agrifood, Canada, was held to discuss bilateral health issues at New Delhi on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.
- 10. A meeting between Hon'ble HFM and H.E. Sibongile Simelane, Minister of Health, Swaziland, was held to discuss bilateral health issues New Delhi on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.

- 11. Hon'ble HFM held bilateral meetings and (a) Dr. Ren Minghui, ADG(HTM), WHO; (b) Dr. Tedros Adhanom, Ethiopian Special Adviser; (c) Health Minister of Nepal; and Health Minister of Myanmar at New Delhi on 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.
- 12. A meeting of Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) for continuation of National Health Mission from 1.4.2017 to 31.3.2020 under the Chairmanship of Finance Secretary and Secretary, Department of Expenditure was held on 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2017.
- 13. Letter of Permission for establishment of 1(one) new dental college with 50 BDS admission intake for the BDS schemes for academic year 2017-18, Letters of Permission for starting/increase of seats for 1881 PG Seats and Notifications/Letters for Recognition in respect of 146 PG Courses have been issued.
- 14. Ministry celebrated the World TB day. 2017 at New Delhi on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2017.
- 15. Under National Programme for Control of Blindness, in March, 2017, approximately 5 lakh cataract surgeries were performed and around 3,921 donated eyes were collected.
