
Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the release of grant-in-aid of Rs.20,50,000/-(Rupees Twenty lakhs fifty thousand only) being the part first instalment of funds out of Rs. 5,28,00,000/- (first instalment) for establishing Centres of Excellence in the field of Mental Health by upgrading and strengthening the under mentioned mental hospitals/ institutes for addressing the acute manpower gap & provision of state of the art mental health care facilities in the long run. The grant – in – aid will be released to the respective State Health Societies through a combined Cheque favoring "ICICI Bank A/C Ministry of Health & Family Welfare" which may be arranged from the PAO (Sectt) as per the details given below:

2. The grant-in-aid is subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- The funds may be kept in a separate account and operated by at least two officials jointly.
- The grant-in-aid should be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned. The assets acquired out of the grant should not without the prior sanction of the Government of India be disposed of, encumbered or utilized for any purpose other than for which the grant is sanctioned.
- The grant-in-aid is subject to the conditions and principles laid down in Rule 206 to 212 of the General financial Rules, 2005 and instructions there under, modified from time to time as well as other specific conditions that may be circulated from time to time.



- d) The accounts of the grantee institution/ organisation shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provisions of the CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry, whenever the institution is called upon to do so.
- e) The society is not authorized to divert the grants or entrust the execution of the scheme for which the grant is made to another institution or organization. In case of it not being in a position to execute or complete the assignment, it should forthwith refund to the Government the entire amount of the grant received by it.
- f) A utilization certificate along with an audited statement of accounts should be furnished to this Ministry soon after the grant-in-aid of the institution is audited by the Accountant General's Office/Chartered Accountant as the case may be, to enable the Government to satisfy themselves that the amount has been spent for the purpose for which the grant has been sanctioned.
- g) The grantee institution shall furnish progress report of the activity in the prescribed proforma to the State Health Society and this Ministry. The concerned State Health Society shall ensure the submission of the progress report of the activity to the Ministry on quarterly basis.
- h) The society should phase and plan the expenditure so as to keep within the sanctioned grants for the purpose.

3. The expenditure involved in the sanction is debitable to the following head of account for the year 2009-10 (PLAN): Demand No.46, Major Head -2210 Medical and Public Health, 06101 - Prevention & Control of Diseases, 34, National Mental Health Programme, 340031- Grants-in-aid.

4. This sanction issues with the concurrence of Finance Division vide Dairy No. C.2954 dated 26/3/2010.

5. It is certified that the amount of the grant-in-aid sanctioned is within the provisions made in the year 2009-10 (Plan).

6. There is no UC pending on account of the above mentioned State Health Society.
